

I am writing in the hopes that members of the KVA may be able to assist me in two projects that I have. I am a small Canadian publisher of books on Canada's military experience ([www.servicepub.com](http://www.servicepub.com)). My books examine the 'material culture' (badges, guns, vehicles, etc..) and not histories or biographies. In 16 years I have published over 60 titles and my books are found in all DND-accredited museums, as well as in libraries across Canada and by militaria collectors world-wide.

The two projects that I am working on include; an illustrated "1953 Clothing and Dress Instructions" which will show the insignia and uniforms of the Canadian Army between 1947 and 1968. For this project I am looking for photos of the various orders of dress in wear. This includes, Mess Dress, Patrols, Service dress, summer Service Dress, bush uniform, etc... The second project is specifically on the equipment used by the Canadian Army in Korea with an emphasis on Small Arms, Artillery and Armour, although RCEME, Sigs, Engineers equipment, etc., will also be covered.

Both of these projects will benefit from contemporary photos of the items in use and the best source for these is usually the soldier who served in theatre. If there is some method by which this request could be transmitted to your membership via your newsletter or e-mail fan-out I would be very grateful. I can either accept high resolution scans (at 300DPI) or the actual photos which I will scan and return.

I am a former officer of the Canadian Forces (Captain, GGFG) and a member of the Organization of Military Museums of Canada (OMMC). I am also a Peacekeeping veteran having served nine months in Haiti (2009) with the RCMP as well as the Vice-President of the Ottawa chapter of Canadian Veterans of UN Peacekeeping (CAVUNP).
